

Harriet Druker

Harriet Druker is a Genetic Counsellor and the Account Manager for Ontario and the Atlantic Provinces for PreventionGenetics, part of Exact Sciences. She obtained her BSc in Biology and MSc in Genetic Counselling from McGill University and an MBA from the Schulich School of Business at York University. Harriet has worked in the rare disease space for over 25 years, largely as a clinical genetic counsellor in the fields of prenatal, paediatrics, and paediatric cancer genetics.

From 2000 -2018, Harriet served as the senior genetic counsellor in the first paediatric Cancer Genetics Program in North America, which she helped to establish at The Hospital for Sick Children. In that role, she published "Genetic Counselor Recommendations for Cancer Predisposition Evaluation and Surveillance in the Pediatric Oncology Patient", which has been used as a guideline for clinics internationally. She was an invited member of international consortium groups to develop and publish surveillance protocols for many rare paediatric cancer conditions. Harriet initiated the development of and directed the Cancer Genetic Counselling Course at The University of Toronto from 2000-2017 and continues to be involved as a clinical supervisor at The University of Toronto in the Division of Molecular Genetics. In 2022, Harriet was awarded a Circle of Excellence Award by Exact Sciences for being in the top 7% of the global sales force.
