Spring Holter obtained her Master's degree in human genetics/genetic counseling from the University of Michigan in 2005. After graduating, she joined the Familial Gastrointestinal Cancer Registry at Mount Sinai Hospital in Toronto providing genetic services to patients and families with hereditary gastrointestinal cancer syndromes. She also became involved in pancreatic cancer research with Dr. Steven Gallinger. She has become a leading expert in pancreatic cancer clinical genetics in Canada. She is a member of the Ontario Health hereditary cancer testing criteria working group and was a vocal advocate in obtaining provincial funding for genetic testing for all patients with pancreatic cancer regardless of age or family history. She joined the University Health Network in 2021 and now focuses on providing genetic counselling services to patients and families with hepatobiliary/pancreatic cancers.
