Susan Howell is an Assistant Professor at the University of Colorado School of Medicine, and has worked as the Genetic Counselor for the eXtraordinary Kids Clinic, Fragile X Clinic and Turner Syndrome Clinic at Children's Hospital Colorado since 2008. During her tenure in Colorado, Susan has worked on a multitude of research projects including several industry-sponsored clinical trials of targeted treatments in Fragile X syndrome, the CDC-funded Fragile X Registry, FORWARD, several NIH-funded clinical trials of testosterone treatment in infants and adolescents with Klinefelter syndrome, and currently an NIH-funded natural history study of prenatally diagnosed babies with sex chromosome aneuploidies. She currently serves as the co-chair of the Colorado Genetic Counseling Educational Symposium as well as a board member for the national X&Y aneuploidy support group, AXYS.
